Instructional Program Offerings

Instructional program offerings of the District conform to Idaho State law and the rules and regulations of the State Board of Education, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction, and other applicable administrative agencies. State curriculum guides shall be used by the staff to ensure that compliance with minimum State standards for subject matter, continuity, and instructional time are met. All areas and levels of instruction shall emphasize training in citizenship, respect for authority, self-respect and self-esteem, values, character building qualities, and critical thinking and decision-making skills.

Instruction in the Constitution of the United States shall be given in all schools in the District as determined by the State Board of Education. Instruction in the proper use, display and history of, and respect for the American flag and the national colors shall be given in all schools. Such instruction shall include the pledge of allegiance to the flag and the words and music of the national anthem and of "America."
