School Closure

The Superintendent may order the closure of schools in the event of extreme weather, facility failures, or other emergency in compliance with established procedures for notifying parents, students, and staff.

State law allows a maximum of 11 hours, or approximately two days, of emergency closure without having to make up lost time. Emergency closures exceeding 11 hours will be made up at a time during the school year as determined by the Board.
