## Student Rights and Responsibilities

All students are entitled to enjoy the rights protected by the Federal and State Constitutions and laws for persons of their age and maturity in a school setting. Students should exercise these rights reasonably and avoid violating the rights of others. Students who violate the rights of others or violate District policies or rules will be subject to disciplinary measures.

These rights and responsibilities may be described at greater length in student handbooks. The Principal, of each school in the District shall prepare or have prepared a student handbook which shall contain the most relevant aspects of the District Policy Manual. Student handbooks may describe or explain District policies. They may also include school policies not addressed in District policy. However, the schools shall adopt any policy which contradicts the policy adopted by the District. The Board will review student handbooks and adopt them as policy. The complete student handbook for each school is on file at the District administration office and at the respective schools.

Students who violate the provisions of the applicable student handbook will be disciplined in accordance with the District policies.
