

Professional Technical Education

The District will strive to provide a program of professional technical education to assist students in making informed and meaningful occupational choices and to prepare students for enrollment in advanced or skilled professional technical training programs. Professional technical program goals may address leadership, life skills, and avocations. Such programs may be included as a part of the regular curriculum. The professional technical offered may be related to employment demands, current and future, and to the needs and interests of the students and the community.

Provision may be made for professional technical for the students enrolled or planning to enroll in professional technical courses. Assistance in job placement, annual follow up studies on students who have graduated from each program, and annual program evaluations may be conducted.

The Board shall approve members for the various professional technical advisory committees as required by individual program policies. Such committees may be made up of faculty, Board Members, and employers or other community members who are knowledgeable in the specific professional technical area being planned. Such committees shall be advisory in nature and shall report directly or indirectly to the Board on educational objectives, instructional content, and program evaluations.
