

School Accountability Report Card

A School Accountability Report Card will be developed and published annually for each of the schools in the District in accordance with State requirements. The following criteria will be met:

1. The annual report card for each school, which covers the school year immediately preceding, shall be published each year. Each school shall publicize such report card and notify parents/guardians of each student that a copy will be provided to them upon request.
2. The report cards shall assess, at the minimum, each of the areas of instruction and operation described in I.C. § 33-4501(1).
3. Each report card may be developed by a building committee consisting of the principal, teachers, parents, and patrons of the District.
4. If a model for the report card other than the model prescribed by the State is used, the Board may compare the categories of the report card with the State model and make a written report of any differences that exist.
5. The report cards will be analyzed to find the strengths and weaknesses within the schools. The weaknesses may then be targeted for program and curriculum improvement within the District.
6. The report card's information will be part of the strategic plan located on the District website.
