Cooperative Programs with Other Districts and Public Agencies

Whenever it appears to the economic, administrative and educational advantage of the District to participate in cooperative programs with other units of government, the Superintendent shall prepare and present for the Board's consideration an analysis of each cooperative proposal.

Cooperative agreements shall comply with the requirements of State and federal law with assurances that all parties to the agreement have the legal authority to engage in the activities proposed by the agreement.

Liaison with School Boards' Association

The Board is permitted to join the Idaho School Boards Association. Since the association provides services in response to members' needs and develops and implements a legislative program at the direction of its members, Board Members are encouraged to participate in the governance of the association. Affiliation with the National School Boards Association and attendant expenses may also be authorized by the board.
