

District Safety

The Board recognizes that safety and health standards should be incorporated into all aspects of the operation of the District. Rules for safety and prevention of accidents shall be posted in compliance with Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) requirements. Injuries and accidents shall be reported to the District office.

All accidents involving student and staff personnel shall be reported in writing to the building administrator as soon as practical. Copies of the accident reports shall be forwarded to the Superintendent's office.

Accidents will be investigated and if it is determined that the accident was preventable, immediate steps will be taken to prevent further accidents.

Safety education is an extremely important part of the educational program. Appropriate instruction may include, but not be limited to, traffic and pedestrian safety, bicycle safety, and driver education.

Building principals shall be responsible for the development of safety programs and shall ensure that the programs are being implemented according to requirements and that such implementation is documented.
